#### -Miracle Makers-

- Anthem LemonAid-

For Children's Miracle Network Richmond and Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield, the month of July means "putting the squeeze" on pediatric cancer by selling a cold glass of LemonAid! This refreshing "kids helping kids" fundraiser is open to the public and at no cost to you...just add water and a smile! Volunteers are recruited to help with kit assembly, kit distribution and the Celebration Event.

**When:** July

**Who:** opportunity is open to all; great for families, community organizations, day cares and businesses

**Requirements:** any age to participate in Anthem LemonAid but must be at least 16 years of age or have adult supervision to volunteer

**Volunteer Opportunities:**

- **Kit Assembly-** requires some lifting, participation in assembly-line work, located indoors, water provided. This opportunity is stretched over 3-4 days with varying hours; typically need 15-20 volunteers each day.
- **Kit Distribution-** requires lifting 10-15 lbs, located outdoors under a tent, water provided. This opportunity is stretched over 3-4 days with varying hours; typically need 8-10 volunteers each day.
- **Celebration Event-** (scheduled for the Sunday of LemonAid weekend) Volunteers are recruited to set-up, teardown, monitor inflatables, located outdoors, some lifting required, lemonade provided.



## -Holiday Gift Wrap Booth-

Get “wrapped” up in the spirit of giving your time during the holiday season. Each fall, Regency Square Mall offers a gift-wrap service to all mall customers. The Virginia Credit Union League and Children’s Miracle Network organize this service to benefit local member hospitals. This service is available each day from November 27th to December 24th. Each shift requires a minimum of 5 volunteers with varying hours to include daytime and evening opportunities.

**When:** November 27th– December 24th

**Who:** opportunity open to all-great for businesses, clubs and community organizations

**Requirements:** must be at least 18 years of age or have adult supervision to volunteer and must attend MANDATORY training session to volunteer. Requires use of cash register and comfort level in gift-wrapping, all supplies provided, service provided for all Regency Square Mall customers.
